

Argyle Sales Tax Election

The Local Sales Tax in the Town of Argyle is **2.0%**.

The Local Sales Tax in the Harvest SPA area of Argyle is **1.25%**.

SPA stands for Special Purpose Annexation, a voluntary annexation which allows the Town of Argyle to share in the sales tax revenue from commercial development.

The Harvest SPA area of Argyle are the restaurants, the future grocery and other nearby businesses on FM407. The lower sales tax rate in that zone traces back to the original creation of Belmont FWSD #2 and the creation of the Special Purpose Annexation (SPA) area.

For the rates in the Harvest Special Purpose Annexation (SPA) area of Argyle and the Town of Argyle to match, both at 2%, voters are asked the following ballot question:

"Shall the Town of Argyle adopt a local sales and use tax in the Town of Argyle city limits and in special purpose annexation areas at the rate of 2 percent (2%)?"

Voting **FOR** the proposition means:

The Harvest SPA area will pay the same rate as the rest of Argyle and the local sales tax rate in the Town of Argyle will not change.

Voting **AGAINST** the proposition means:

The Harvest SPA will have a lower sales tax rate than businesses in the rest of the Town of Argyle.



The Town of Argyle encourages voters to express their opinion by voting in the **November 4 election**. Early voting begins **October 20**.
