Recycling and Waste Service Guide

Basic Services and Schedule

Waste collection once a week - **EVERY MONDAY**

Bundled Brush and Bulk Collection - **EVERY MONDAY**; up to 2 cubic yards (approximately 3'x3'x6' will be collected)

Recycling - **EVERY MONDAY**

When should I set my containers out?

Be sure your recycling and waste containers are set out for collection by 7:00 a.m. on **MONDAY**.

Container Placement

Place your recycling and waste containers two feet away from each other and away from the edge of the street. Make sure the handle is facing your house, so that the lid opens toward the street. Please check to see that they are not obstructed by parked cars, boats, etc.

Brush and Bulk

Brush and bulk items are collected **EVERY MONDAY**. Brush must be cut to 4 foot lengths and tied in bundles. Furniture, boxes, other household items too big to fit inside your container and construction debris (generated from your house only) will also be collected. Non-compactables like brick, concrete, dirt, composition shingles, etc. must be placed in containers. Containers and bundles must not weigh more than 50 pounds.
